**ORDINANCE NO. 599**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF MOUND CITY, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE “STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES,” EDITION OF 2024; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 590.**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MOUND CITY, KANSAS:**

Section 1. **INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE:** There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Mound City, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the “Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities,” Edition of 2024, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. One copy of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped “Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 599,” repealing Ordinance No. 590 and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.


Section 2. **INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE:** There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Mound City, Kansas, that certain code known as the “Uniform Public Offense Code,” Edition of 2024, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than (3) copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped “Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 599,” repealing Ordinance No. 590 and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be opened to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Uniform Public Offense Code Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

Section 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Linn County News, the official City newspaper.
